## Skin/Soft Tissue Excisional Biopsy for Pathology/Histology Analysis

**Test:** Pigmented Lesion (r/o melanoma) panel

Non-Pigmented Lesion (r/o carcinoma) panel

Ulceration panel

Tumor (Ganglion/Lipoma/Sarcoma) panel Inflammatory (Tophus/Abscess) panel

**Submission Criteria:** An ellipse of skin and subcutaneous tissue to, or including, fat. Then

entire lesion should be excised with a border of normal skin. Place

immediately into formalin.

**Rejection Criteria:** Rejection criteria include but are not limited to those with:

1. Mismatched requisitions

2. Specimens without two patient identifiers

3. Specimens submitted without approval

**Turnaround Time:** 3 days

Clinical Significance: For evaluation of an entire, solitary lesion with surrounding normal

tissue. Preferred method for inflammatory of deep dermal lesions

and when melanoma is suspected.

**Reference Ranges:** Not detected for all targets

**Method:** Panels are comprised of one or more of the following:

Hematoxylin and Eosin Stain Periodic Acid – Schiff Stain

Grocott's Methenamine Silver Stain

Gram' Stain

Fontana Masson Stain

Immunohistochemical Staining
